All dressage tests for CT classes and Intro level classes will be ridden in a small (20x40m) arena. All others will be ridden in a standard (40x60m) arena.

Entry Fees: Combined Tests \$35, Dressage Tests \$25 Side Saddle classes \$25 each or both for \$40

Entries limited to 80; max 2 horses/rider. Entries must be in the hands of the secretary by closing date. Late entries (postmarked after Jan. 2 2010) may be accepted, space permitting, with an additional \$10 late fee. Negative coggins within 12 months of show date must be sent with entry. Refunds: Before closing date: original check will be destroyed. After closing date: **none**. Scratches and changes must be in writing to the secretary—email and fax OK. In the event of show cancellation, a portion of entry fees may be returned after show expenses are met.

Other Information:

In general, USEA/USEF/USDF rules will be followed. It is the competitor's responsibility to know and abide by the rules. Hard hat required while mounted. ASTM/SEI approved hard hat with fastened safety harness required for all jumping phases and for Juniors at all times. Riders must wear current emergency medical info armband while jumping. Divisions may be further divided/combined based on age and experience. Be sure to include this information on your entry form! Braiding and jackets are optional. No chaps please. Limited concessions available. All dogs must be leashed!

Limited stabling may be available within 5-10 miles. Please contact the secretary with any requests.

Directions: Three Runs Plantation is located on White Pond Road in Aiken, SC; just north of New Ellenton, SC.. From I-20: Take Exit #18. Travel US Hwy 19 South approximately 5 miles toward Aiken. Turn **LEFT** on Richland Avenue (in downtown Aiken). Go approximately 2 blocks and turn **RIGHT** on Chesterfield St. South. Chesterfield becomes Whiskey Road. Travel approximately 7 miles on Whiskey Road. Turn **LEFT** on White Pond Road. The entrance to Three Runs Plantation is approximately 2.5 miles on the right.
